**INCORPORATING QUALIFIERS FOR THE AMATEUR SHOWING SOCIETY NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**Ring One – Show jumping - Commencing 9am**

**Class 1** Beginners/ Novice Pony – 1ft 6 - 1ft 9

*Combination of horse and rider not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in any show jumping event off lead rein. Lead reins permitted and at the discretion of the judge we will allow you to complete the course regardless of faults incurred although these competitors will not go through to the jump off.*

**Class 2** Intermediate Pony – 2ft 3 – 2ft 6

**Class 3** Open Pony – 2ft 6 – 2ft 9

**Class 4** Beginners/ Novice Horse – 2ft 3 – **Not before 12pm**

*Combination of horse and rider not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any show jumping event. Competitors will be allowed to complete the course at the discretion of the judge regardless of faults incurred but they will not go through to the jump off.*

**Class 5** Intermediate Horse – 2ft 6 – 2ft 9

**Class 6** Open Horse -2ft 9 – 3ft

**Class 7** Pairs Relay – Open to Ponies & Horses – Riders any age.

*The pairs relay will be run over a course of 8 show jumps with the first 4 jumps set at a height of 2ft and the last 4 set at a height of 2ft 6. The first member of each pair will jump the first 4 jumps before handing over to their team member who will complete the final set of 4 jumps. The winning pair will have the quickest combined clear round.*

**Class 8** Horse and Hound – Fences 2ft – Open to Ponies & Horse & Riders any age.

*The competitor will be required to complete a course of 6 show jumps before dismounting and handing their Horse/Pony over to a designated helper before running around the same course with their dog. The winning team will have the quickest combined clear round.*

**Ring two – Showing – Commencing 10am**

**Class 9** Lead Rein Showing – Ponies under 13.2hh & competitors under 12

**Class 10** Riding Club Pony – Not Exc 14.2hh – Competitors will be required to do an individual show and jump a small obstacle of approx 2ft. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle.

**Class 11** Riding Club Horse – Exc 14.2hh – Competitors will be required to do an individual show and jump a small obstacle of approx 2ft 6. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle.

**Class 12** Open in hand – Open to all horses & ponies – any shape, any breed, any colour, any age. Will be judged on confirmation, turnout & manners. Class will be split in to ponies/horses if size of class warrants.

**Class 14** Ridden Coloured – Open to ponies & horses – To be judge on confirmation, turnout & manners. Competitors will be required to do an individual show.

**Class 15** Ridden Thoroughbred – Open to any horse registered as a thoroughbred, to be judged on confirmation, turnout & manners.

Competitors will be required to do an individual show.

**Class 16** Veteran – Open to ponies & horses over 15 years old. Competitors will be required to do an individual show.

**Class 17** Championship – All 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place competitors to compete for showing champion & reserve.



**Ring three - Fun Ring – Commencing 11am**

**Class 18** The horse or pony the judge would most like to take home – In hand or ridden.

**Class 19** Fancy Dress – Theme “Olympics”

**Class 20** Condition & Turnout – Lead reins permitted

**Class 21** Gymkhana Class 21a) Egg & Spoon

Class 21 b) Ride & Run

Class 21c) Apple Bobbing

The age categories for the gymkhana will be 7 & under, 12 and under and open.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1: The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entries.
- 2: Competitors may be disqualified from any class for causing any unnecessary delay to the continuity of the event.
- 3: Entry fees are NOT refundable under any circumstances after the close of entry unless cancelled by the organisers or on presentation of a current Vet's certificate or Doctor's note.
- 4: Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the occurrence or the publishing of results accompanied by a £20 deposit. No video evidence will be considered under any circumstances
- 5: Legal Liability. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, Suffolk Young Farmers Clubs or Mid Suffolk Showground, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accept any liability for any accident, loss damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other persons or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
- 6: No horses/ponies under 4 years of age allowed to compete.
- 7: Health and Safety. The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
- 8: HAT REGULATIONS – It is mandatory to wear a protective helmet manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed. It must bear the CE mark and a quality symbol. PAS 015:1998, EN 1384:1996, BS EN 1384:1997 together with the BSI Kitemark. Snell E2001, with the official Snell label and number, AS/NZS 3838 1998, AS/NZS 3838 2003 with the SAI Global symbol. The CE symbol on its own is not sufficient. Hats must be worn when mounted, with chin strap fastened at all times. Hats with long ventilation slits are not allowed for anyone over the age of 9 yrs old. Hats with vertical plastic/metallic strips are permitted.
- 9: No trotting or cantering in public areas - only in designated warm up areas.
- 10: Please ensure dogs are kept on leads at all times.
