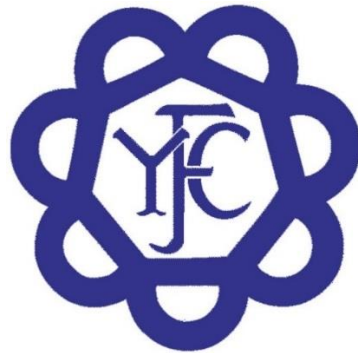
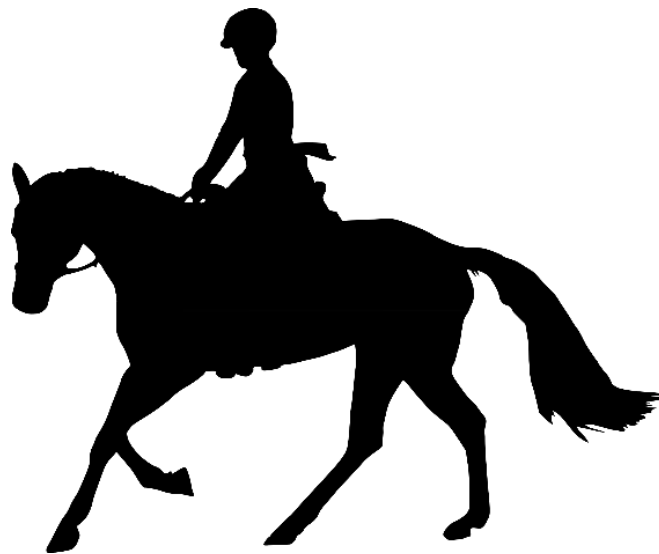

To qualify for the 2019 National Supreme Showing Championship Show, Venue/Date TBC the first, second and third highest placed 15+ horse/pony in the following classes, 4 & 16, will each qualify. To enter the National Supreme Showing Championship Show the rider/handler and horse/pony must register with 15+ Horse & Pony Events within 14 days of the qualifying show date. TSR Showing Finals – This show is a qualifier for the TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk>

RING 1 – 9:30 AM - JUDGE – TBC

CLASS 1: LEAD REIN/FIRST RIDDEN lead rein rider 10 years and under. First ridden 12 years and under. Mare or gelding 4 years and over. Any height Both highest placed lead rein and first ridden will qualify.

Qualifier for: ESUK, TSR, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 2: NUPAFEEED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS & FUTURE IMAGES LTD / EQUIFEST MAXI COBS

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

☑ Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

☑ Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. Riders any age.

Qualifier for: Equifest, ESUK, TSR, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 3: BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries.

Qualifier for: Equifest, ESUK, TSR, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 4: RIDDEN VETERAN years and over. Lead rein allowed. This class will be split horses and ponies. 1st – 3rd in both horses and ponies will qualify to 15+.

Qualifier for: 15+, Esuk, TSR, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 5: RIDDEN ROR (Re Training Of Rachehorses)

Qualifier for: ESUK, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 6: EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

This class may be divided as appropriate.

Qualifier for: Equifest, ESUK, TSR, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 7: BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.

Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.

Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.

Qualifier for: ESUK, TSR, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 8: Broadbandandphones.co.uk / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PART BREDS

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as appropriate.

Qualifier for: Equifest, ESUK, TSR

CLASS 9: NUPAFEEED / EQUIFEST RIDING HORSES

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

☑ Small Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

☑ Large Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

Qualifier for: ESUK, TSR, Sunshine Tour

CLASS 10: CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE RIDDEN OR INHAND 4 years old and over. Riders any age. Lead rein allowed

CLASS 18: INHAND VETERAN 15 years and over. This class will be split horses and ponies. 1st – 3rd in both horses and ponies will qualify to 15+.

CLASS 19: SPILLERS / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

This class may be divided as appropriate.

Conditions of Entry

1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entries
2. Competitors may be disqualified from any class for causing unnecessary delay to the continuity of the event
3. Entry fees are non-refundable under any circumstances after the close of entry unless cancelled by the organisers or on presentation of a current vet's certificate or doctors note.
4. Objections must be made in writing to the secretary within 30 minutes of the occurrence or the publishing of results accompanied by a £20 deposit. No video evidence will be considered under any circumstances.
5. Legal Liability. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, Suffolk Young Farmers Club or Easton farm Park, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accept any liability for any accident, loss damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other persons or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
6. No Horses/Ponies under 4 years of age can compete in ridden classes
7. Health & Safety. The organisers of this event have taken responsible precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all responsible precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
8. HAT REGULATIONS – It is mandatory to wear a protective helmet manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed. Hats bearing only the EN1384 or BSEN1384 standard will no longer be accepted under BHS hat rules 2016.
However, hats would be acceptable if they carry EN1384 or BSEN1384 and another standard such as those stated: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011), VG1 01.040 (2014-12), ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards), SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards). Hats must be worn when mounted, with chin strap fastened at all times. Hats with vertical plastic/metallic straps are permitted.
9. No trotting or cantering in public areas – only in designated warm up areas
10. Please ensure dogs are kept on leads at all times.
11. Please note: All horses attending the show should be hand-able, safe and sensible. All riders are responsible for their own Horse & Rider insurance and handling of their animals at all times. Suffolk Young Farmers cannot be held responsible for any liability concerning your horse during the country fair.
12. There will be no mucking out of trailers or boxes on the showground under any circumstances. All muck MUST be taken home with you
13. With the current Equine Flu scare, we ask that your horses are full vaccinated when attending the show, and you are able to show evidence of that if asked by one of our officials or stewards.
